Rules and Regulations for the Pipefitters Local 208

2015 Scholarship Program

- 1. The applicant must be a dependent son or daughter of a current active member of Pipefitters Local Union 208.
- 2. A dependent son or daughter is defined as a member's unmarried child (including legally adopted child or foster child) who is less than 26 years of age and is solely dependent upon you for support and maintenance while spending their time in college.
- 3. The member must be a current active member in Pipefitters Local Union 208 and not be working contrary to the Pipefitters Local Union 208 Collective Bargaining Agreement or in violation of Pipefitters Local Union 208 by-laws or the United Association Constitution.
- 4. The member must have been employed for at least 2000 hours within the previous four fiscal years July 1, 2011 through June 30, 2015 for an employing contractor signatory to a Pipefitters Local Union 208 Collective Bargaining Agreement.

FIRST AWARD

- 5. An applicant applying for their first award must:
 - a. Be eligible to enter into college or continue attending college as of September 2015.
 - b. Submit a certified transcript of high school grades and or, if already attending college, a transcript of such college grades.
 - c. Submit both verbal and mathematical SAT scores.
 - d. Submit a completed application form by certified mail to:

Applications may be obtained at the Pipefitters Local Union Office.

6. All applications for the September 2015 academic year must be received on or before Friday, June 19th, 2015. Applications received after that date will not be considered.

CONTINUING AWARDS

7. Applicants who have previously received a Scholarship Award are eligible for consideration for additional awards in the succeeding academic years providing that their academic record is satisfactory and they are eligible under the Compliance Rules; such applications will be considered along with applications from those individuals with the greatest promise.
