(Please read carefully)

- The applicant must be a dependent son or daughter of a current active member of Pipefitters Local Union 208
- 2. A dependent son or daughter is defined as a member's unmarried child (including legally adopted child) who is less than 26 years of age and is solely dependent upon you for support and maintenance while spending their time in college
- 3. The member must be a current active member in Pipefitters Local Union 208 and not be working contrary to the Pipefitters Local Union 208 Collective Bargaining Agreement or in violation of Pipefitters Local Union 208 By-Laws or the United Association Constitution
- 4. The member must have been employed for at least 2000 hours within the previous four fiscal years July 1, 2015 through June 30, 2019 for an employing contractor signatory to a Pipefitters Local Union 208 Collective Bargaining Agreement
- 5. Application must be filled out by the member and applicant. Please type or print clearly
- 6. Enclosed with your application, (2) two <u>Sealed letters of recommendations</u> (must be sealed and initialed at the seal by the teacher or person writing the <u>letter (NO previous letters accepted)</u> At least one of these letters must be from your teacher or another person in a <u>position to evaluate your academic performance and ability</u>
- 7. For returning applicants you MUST have (2) new recommendation letters from (2) NEW teachers or person (s) that can evaluate your academic performance
- 8. Returning applicants must provide their <u>certified college grades</u> transcript (no printed copies from the computer)
- Enclose a letter of acceptance to the University or College you will be attending
- 10. **Returning applicants**, we need a letter of submission to your next year
- 11. The Certification page with members and applicants must be returned

FIRST AWARD

An applicant applying for their first award must:

- a. Be eligible to enter college or continue attending college as of September 2020
- b. Submit a <u>certified transcript of high school grades (no copies)</u> and or, if already attending college, a transcript of such college grades
- c. Submit both verbal and mathematical SAT scores
- d. Submit an acceptance letter into the College you will be attending

CONTINUING AWARDS

SELECTION PROCESS

No employer representative or union representative participates in the selection process. Applicants will be considered regardless of race, creed, color, national original or sex. **The decisions are final**

COMPLIANCE RULES

Each recipient of the Scholarship Award must take enough units to qualify as a full-time student for the academic year. The last page of the scholarship application contains a pledge to be signed by the recipient and parents that in the event the recipient does not attend a college or university in the academic year for which the scholarship is awarded, or does not complete the required number of units, or should drop out of college prior to the completion of the academic year, other than by virtue of serious illness or induction into the armed services, the money shall be promptly repaid to the Pipefitters Local Union 208 Scholarship Fund.

To assure compliance with the terms of the award, the recipient must forward to Pipefitters Local Union 208 office, a certificate of registration as to courses taken within three months of the beginning of the academic years. The recipient must also submit a transcript of courses and grades at the end of the academic year.
